 - 3. By the Word of God I Pet. 1:22,23; Eph. 5:25,26

 - 1. Ability to overcome temptation I Jn. 3:9; 5:4
 - 2. <u>Attitude</u> changes I Jn. 4:19; 5:1; Ps. 119:97
