 - i. Psychological, philosophical, even scientific
- b. We are fools Rom.1:21-22

II. Impostors of truth

- a. <u>Rationalism</u> only what is logically and rationally perceived is truth
- b. Pragmatism only what works is truth
- Subjectivism truth changes dependent upon your perspective
- d. <u>Relativism</u> "I call em' like I see em' = what I see is truth
- e. <u>Post-modernism</u> "I call em' like I want it to be" = what I want is my truth

- a. Exists admit it, confess it
- b. Is Knowable
- c. Is an absolute
- d. Is deeper than mere facts IITim.3:7
