 - B. The Kingdom involves 4 inter-related concepts
 - 1. God's kingship, rule or recognized sovereignty
 - 2. It is spiritual in nature
 - 3. Its visible manifestation today is in the form of the Church
 - 4. It involves the "new heavens and new earth"
 - C. It is proper to think of the Kingdom in both a present and <u>future</u> sense

 - 1. Appreciate the character and blessedness of the <u>citizens</u> of the Kingdom Matt. 5:3-16
 - 2. Understand the need for the <u>righteousness</u> expected of its citizens Matt. 5:17-7:12
