- A. They talked a lot and did a little
- B. They were all about appearances
- C. They picked and chose what they liked
- D. They loved money

#### II. The Righteousness of the Kingdom

- A. We cannot say one thing and do another
- B. We are not to do things for the appearance of others
- C. We cannot <u>neglect</u> the parts we don't like
- D. We are not to be lovers of money

# III. Warnings for those who think they can be Christians and not obey Scripture

- A. When there is a <u>disconnect</u> with our profession of faith and our conduct James 2:14-17; I Jn. 2:4-6; I Jn 3:18
- B. When our personal private lives are not <u>consistent</u> with our public appearance Mark 4:22
- C. When we don't make <u>diligent</u> effort to observe ALL that Jesus commanded Matt. 28:20; Jn. 8:31,32
- D. When we fall into the trap of <u>materialism</u> I Tim. 6:9,10; I Jn. 2:15-17

## IV. Takeaway:

- A. Without question, our righteousness as citizens of the Kingdom must <u>exceed</u> that of the Scribes & Pharisees by actively pursuing a deeper relationship with Him
- B. Only by the grace of God can we live this righteous life
