### I. The context

- a. It was all about choices
  - i. The kingdom of the world
  - ii. The kingdom of heaven
- b. It set in place:
  - i. The right <u>attitudes</u> Matt.5:3-12
  - ii. The right influences Matt.5:13-16
  - iii. The right motives Matt.5:21-48
  - iv. Where to seek praise Matt.6:1-18
- c. It set the ingredients
  - i. Singlemindedness Matt.6:19-24
  - ii. Reliance on the Father Matt.6:25-30
  - iii. Positive relationships Matt.7:12

## II. The two ways (paths)

- a. Represent two different lifestyles
  - i. Continual, reoccurring choices
- b. The popular way
  - i. Easy to find, <u>easy</u> to live
  - ii. Appeals to the flesh IJn.2:15-16
- c. The <u>unpopular</u> way
  - i. It is the way the Lord wants for us
  - ii. It will be hard to find and live (faith vs. sight) II Cor. 4:18

# III. The two groups

- a. They are <u>believers</u>
  - i. Service, not salvation
- b. The many will choose the easy way
  - i. Go along to get along
- c. The few <u>LOOK</u> for the hard way
  - i. Those that don't look, don't find

# IV. The two destinations

- a. <u>Destruction</u>
  - i. Natural consequences and <u>lost</u> eternal <u>rewards</u>
- b. Life
  - i. <u>Positive</u> natural consequences
  - ii. Eternal rewards gained II Cor.4:16-17
