1. The Importance of Understanding the Times

- A. Understand why you are here: Acts 17:24-28a
- B. Understand who is in charge: (Isa 46:5-11)
 - God is faithful. Period.
 - God is long-suffering—and he is not e=desiring that anyone should perish!
 - God is in control of all that happens—not matter how bad it gets
 - God is never caught by surprise. To Israel He reminded them that He never slumbers nor sleeps. (Psalm 121)
 - God's plan will prevail and triumph

C. Understand the realm of this world
