 Rom 6:1-7
 - A. NOT:
 - 1. Sinless perfection
 - 2. Old nature is gone
 - B. IS:
 - 1. God's grace demands it v.1,2
 - a) Am I using grace as an excuse?
 - (1) Am I apathetic about certain sin?
 - (2) Do I <u>focus</u> on His "love" more than His "holiness"?
 - (3) Do I abuse forgiveness by choosing sin?
 - 2. Christ's victory assures it v.3-5
 - 3. My experience should confirm it v.6,7
- III. Takeaway: A <u>changed</u> life is full of repentance and constantly acknowledging I am dead to sin
