

Unworthy or Worthy?

ICor.15:9

- I. The Hard truth about who we are
 - a. The Apostle Paul knew his own faults and sins and felt unworthy ITim.1:15
 - b. Elijah witnessed the power of God through his own words and commands
 - i. And yet he felt unworthy to continue living IKings19:1-4
 - c. We are no different Rom.3:11,23
 - d. When we see ourselves, we see unworthiness
 - i. You can't change this on your own Eph.2:12
 - ii. You have no hope in this world on your own
- II. Where is our deliverance/salvation?
 - a. Recognize that what you need the most, you cannot work to obtain
 - i. It comes from the grace of God Eph.2:8, Rom.3:24
 - ii. You receive it when you believe it Eph.2:8, Jn.3:16
 - b. Understand that this is available to you because God sees you as worthy IJn.4:10
 - i. God says you are worth it!
- III. How to live in this victory daily
 - a. See yourself as God sees you, not as you see yourself
 - i. Understand the security that is yours Rom.8:35-39
 - b. When you do sin, know that that is not the real you Rom.7:17
 - c. Confess it and trust God for forgiveness and cleansing IJn.1:9
 - d. Know that God's view of you never changes
- IV. The result of knowing we are worthy
 - a. Boldness and confidence Heb.4:16,13:6
